Scripts

Task 1

You will hear a conversation between a woman and Matt. What is each person in Matt's family reading? For questions 1–6 cross out the wrong answer in the table. You will hear the recording twice.

You have 20 seconds to look at the questions.

Pause 20 seconds

Now we are ready to start. Listen carefully. You will hear the recording twice.

Woman: Hello, Matt. Is your mum there? It's auntie Pamela.

Matt: Hi. Yes, but she's rather busy. She's <u>reading a difficult textbook</u> about how to write a good story.

Woman: Can I speak to your <u>dad</u> then?

Matt: Erm, sorry, no. His boss emailed him and told <u>him to read something on</u> an important website. So he's doing that at the moment.

Woman: Well, how about your brother?

Matt: He's reading a message from his friend about their examination.

Woman: And your sister?

Matt: Oh, she's on her mobile. I think she's reading all her text messages and putting some new names and addresses in her address book.

Woman: OK, well can I speak to your <u>uncle</u>? Is he there?

Matt: Yes, but he's reading in the garden. He's reading <u>his motorbike magazine</u>. He reads a lot, but not newspapers. He isn't interested in those.

Woman: Well, can I talk to your <u>cousin</u>?

Matt: He's reading too, so I'm not sure. It's his birthday today and he's <u>reading</u> a <u>comic</u> that I gave him!

Woman: And your grandfather?

Matt: He's busy too. Sorry. He bought a new MP3 player and he's reading the instructions! He's going to put all his CDs on it.

Woman: And what are you doing?

Matt: Nothing! Can I help?

Woman: No, because now I can't remember why I phoned...
